



Singular Nouns and the Simple Present Tense

- Singular means "one." A singular noun is one of something: a book, Wendy Brown, the school, Miami.
- In the simple present, use the -s form of the verb when the subject is a singular noun or he, she, or it. This is called the "third-person singular."

Spelling Changes in the Simple Present Tense

- When the base form of the verb ends in s, sh, ch, or x, add -es.
- When the base form of the verb ends in a consonant + y, change the y to i and add $-\epsilon$
- Add –es to go and do.
- Have is irregular. The –s form of have is has.




